UDOIT Dance Foundation are a charity who aim to inspire, engage and empower people through street dance. We are primarily funded by Sport England & Sport Wales to make Street dance accessible, across the country, primarily in areas of deprivation where young people don't have as many opportunities to experience what street dance can offer. UDOIT Dance Foundation also provides dance leader training, volunteering opportunities, the National Schools Dance championships and bespoke programmes using Street Dance to help with gang crime/ mental health/ physical activity for the elderly
