

Overview:

The UDOIT! Dance Foundation is a charity who aim to inspire, engage and empower people through street dance. We want street dance to be accessible to all, especially to young people from areas of deprivation, so that they can benefit from the significant physical and mental health benefits that Street Dance can offer.

We work with a range of partners and funders across England and Wales, including Sport England, Sport Wales, Street Games, UDO and local councils.

We offer a range of programmes and projects ranging from street dance engagement and delivery, dance leader training, competitions and more specialist programmes using Street Dance to target mental health challenges and also engage with and help young people involved in or at risk of gang or knife crime.

The Role:

As part of our expansion in 2024, UDOIT! are looking to add 2-3 new Trustees to our existing board to help support and shape the next stage in the charity's growth.

While previous experience of being a trustee is not essential, we are looking for enthusiastic individuals who share our core values and goals and who can add new perspectives, insight and skill to the board. We believe strongly in having a diverse board and encourage applicants from all backgrounds and ages to apply if they feel they have the right skill set.

Key responsibilities

• To chair 4-6 Board meetings a year

• To act as an impartial member of the Board, helping to ensure that all decisions taken are in the long-term interest of UDOIT.

- To contribute or chair committees and working groups where required
- To assist in the development of the UDOIT strategy.

• To provide specialist knowledge and skills to the Board in the development and management of its strategy where appropriate;

- To help monitor the risks associated with delivering the strategy
- To help monitor the operational performance of the organisation.
