Safe Recruitment Policy

UDOIT! is committed to safeguarding children (anyone under 18) and adults at risk.

UDOIT! complies with National Safer Recruitment Procedures and relevant legislation to ensure a consistent and thorough recruitment process.

The aim of the Safer Recruitment policy is to help deter people who might abuse children or adults at risk from applying for roles where they will have access to those vulnerable groups.
